Canadian Women of Consequence

Elizabeth Arden



née Florence Nightingale
Graham. Born December 31, 1878
Woodbridge, Ontario. Died October
18, 1966 New York City, New York,
U.S.A.

She left Woodbridge, Ontario for the bright lights of New York City when she was 25 years old. After working as secretary at a cosmetic firm she decided that she would work in the cosmetic business herself. The rest is history.

In 1909 she formed a short lived partnership with Elizabeth Hubbard and the trade name **Elizabeth** was used to save money on her salon signage. She would choose the name Arden from a local farm of that name. In 1910 she founded the Red Door Salon in New York City. In 1912 she traveled to France to learn beauty secrets of Paris salons. In 1934 she opened a residential spa in Rome, Maine the first destination beauty spa in the U.S.A. Along with her rival, Helena Rubenstein, she made make-up acceptable to the average North American woman. She pioneered such concepts as scientific formulation of cosmetics, beauty makeovers and coordination colours of eye, lip and facial makeup.

At the peak of her career, she was one of the wealthiest women in the world. In 1962 she

received the **Legion d'Honneur** from France for her contribution to the cosmetics industry. You can see for yourself all the various products her company makes at most large department stores cosmetic counters. She is buried in Sleepy Hollow, New York under the name Elizabeth N. Gordon

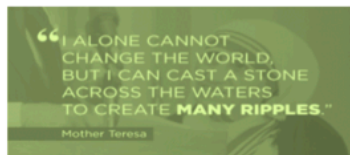
