




Maryam Monsef Founder and CEO of ONWARD

Maryam Monsef is recognized for her resilience as a new Canadian, the first Afghan Canadian Member of Parliament, and visionary entrepreneur dedicated to women's empowerment and equity.

Serving the Peterborough and Kawartha Riding from 2016-2021, Maryam held several portfolios as the Minister for Democratic Institutions, Minister for the Status of Women, Minister of International Development and Minister of Rural and Economic Development.

She established the Department for Women and Gender Equality (WAGE) and rolled out one of the largest investments in high-speed internet. Under her stewardship, Canada was recognized as a world leader in Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights.

Maryam's commitment to domestic and international grassroot women's organizations and her drive for an intersectional response to COVID-19, introduced The Feminist Response and Recovery Fund. The Canadian Federation of Business and Professional Women, (BPW Canada), tapped into this funding and launched the project titled, "Strategic Partnerships for a COVID-19 Response to Promote the Full Participation and Economic Recovery for Women". This work resulted in to the IDEAS4GE Strategy and collaborative solutions now available to stakeholders committed to integrating Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Access into the workplace, marketplace and communities across Canada.
